

## Confirmation Deposit Policy

Students offered admission to the following programs in the College of Health and Human Services are required to pay a non-refundable confirmation deposit by the deadline specified by the departments to reserve their place in the program. This deposit applies to students accepted into the following programs:

- Doctor in Audiology (Au.D.) - \$500
  - Dietetic Internship Certificate Graduate Program - \$500
  - Nurse Anesthesia - \$500
  - Doctor in Nurse Practice (BSN to DNP and Post-Masters DNP) - \$500
  - Bachelor of Science in Nursing (4-year BSN) - \$100
  - Doctor in Physical Therapy (DPT) - \$500
  - Physician Assistant - \$500
- I. Students who receive an acceptance letter from the program they are applying to will be required to pay a confirmation deposit to hold their place in the class.
- a. The confirmation deposit will be applied to tuition, fees, or any other student financial obligation during the student's first term of enrollment following the end of the first week of that semester. Financial Aid will not be impacted by the payment of the confirmation deposit. Once all sources of payment, such as loans, awards, and scholarships, have been applied to the student's bursar account, the student may be entitled to a refund from the University due to overpayment for tuition and fees. This is the only situation in which the student will receive a refund and the amount will be determined based on any funds remaining after payment of all University charges have been settled.
  - b. The confirmation deposit for accepted students is due by the date stipulated in the program acceptance letter and is non-refundable. Students should only pay this deposit if they have received a letter of acceptance from the program for which they have submitted an application. Admission into Missouri State University and/or the Graduate College does not guarantee acceptance into the desired program.
  - c. Failure to pay the confirmation deposit by the deadline forfeits the student's position in the program.
- II. If a student is accepted into a program, pays the confirmation deposit, and notifies a program at any point in time after paying the confirmation deposit that he/she will not be attending Missouri State University, subsequently withdrawing their enrollment from the program from which they were accepted, the confirmation deposit will be forfeited. The program in which the student was accepted into will receive the forfeited deposit.
