



MCHHS Faculty Grants and Contracts Incentive Policy

Deadline: May be submitted to Dean's Office in September and February

The McQueary College of Health & Human Services (MCHHS) at Missouri State University is committed to supporting faculty in the development of external funding proposals to include grants and contractual obligations from individuals; government and public agencies; and industrial financial and private organizations. Outside sources of revenue are important in maintaining academic excellence through education, services, student support, facilities, and research. In addition, these sources of revenue allow faculty members to engage in activities of interest while assuring funds associated with research and project development are available.

External grant submissions with budgets over \$20,000 are eligible for a \$200 incentive payment.

Funded proposals (that budget indirect funds) are eligible for an additional incentive, as follows:

Grant Budget \$10,000 - \$29,999	= \$200
Grant Budget \$30,000 - \$39,999	= \$300
Grant Budget \$40,000 - \$49,999	= \$400
Grant Budget \$50,000 - \$59,999	= \$500
Grant Budget \$60,000 - \$69,999	= \$600
Grant Budget \$70,000 - \$79,999	= \$700
Grant Budget \$80,000 - \$89,999	= \$800
Grant Budget \$90,000 - \$99,999	= \$900
Grant Budget ≥ \$100,000	= \$1000

For all incentive payment requests, please attach the Internal Approval Form (IAF) from the Office of Research Administration when submitting to the Dean's Office. For funded project incentive requests, please attach evidence of the award notification, the assigned budget number, and the IAF.

Eligibility: MCHHS Faculty and Staff

Percent Credit: Contribution or Percent Credit must be 20% or greater for the PI. If the grant allows for multiple PIs, all can apply.

Faculty Development Awards will be granted for the following category of submissions:

- New
- Competitive Renewal

Award will not be granted for the following:

- Extensions or Non - Competitive Renewals
- Revisions

Awards will not be granted if the faculty member received release time to write the grant or contract proposal.
